MAJOR INVESTMENT IN BRO ENLLI

Some of you will have heard the good news in a recent interview on Radio Cymru that a major investment is coming to Bro Enlli. As many of you are aware, St Peter's Church in Pwllheli has been in need of major repairs for some time. Over the years, various plans have been made, some have been discarded as impractical and others have failed to attract funding. We are now at a crunch point where either we succeed or St Peter's will close as the building becomes unsafe. Rather than just repairing the building, we are looking to completely re-vitalise the church to support not only its place as a major town church but also its future as a Marian Shrine and place of Sanctuary, its work amongst the poor in the food bank, its work with children in the toddler group and Sunday school and as a centre for community use, hosting Gwystl's rural market and other community events. In our endeavour to deliver this vision, we have now gained both Provincial and Diocesan support for a £1m investment in St Peter's. We still have a long way to go but, as our Diocesan Secretary has said, we are looking to complete the project within two years. The rest of this year will see a lot of background discussions and work with the Diocese working in partnership with us in Bro Enlli to secure the funding with the aim to start the building works in 2020. We hope to be able to present the full plans for this major investment to the whole Ministry area soon but, for now, please join us in giving thanks for this good news and continue to pray for the project as we take the next steps in ensuring its success to the benefit of the whole of Bro Enlli and our diocese.
